

Captain Ghi Đặng



Ghi Đặng was born July 1st, 1944. He graduated from Reserve Officer Võ Khoa Thủ Đức Accademy in Saigon, South Vietnam, course 25 on January 1968. From 1968-1972, he served in the 22nd Infantry Division in Bình Định as Company Commander. In 1971, he earned a Diploma of Leadership while training in Fort Knox Kentucky. He was a prisoner of war in Communist North Vietnam in 1972-73. From December 1973 to 1975, he was Company Commander and then leader of section 3 of the 244 Battalion in Tuyên Đức Đà Lạt. After April 1975, he was a prisoner in Đại Bình Communist re-education camp in Lâm Đồng until 1982.

Ghi Đặng married Huỳnh Lang T. Lê. They have three children Quỳnh Giao, Cliff Đức and Vi Vân. They were accepted to H.O. program

and immigrated to the USA in April 2nd 1991.

The family settled and started a new life in Washington State.

In the USA, Ghi Đặng earned an A.A.S Degree in Landscaping from South Seattle Community College. His name was on the National Dean's List 1992 – 1993 and 1993 – 1994. He is listed on International Who's Who in 1999.

In 2000, Ghi Đặng's company DG Landscapes Inc. was recognized by King County as an outstanding King County contractor.

Ghi Đặng was also awarded the Community Service Award from the Vietnamese American Bar Association of Washington (VABAW) in 2007.
